**Keeping the children healthy this time of year is always challenging. Our health policy is based upon state regulations as well as, the physical and emotional welfare of the children. If your child becomes ill while at school, you will be called to pick them up. For your child's comfort as well as the well - being of all the children, you are expected to pick up your child within 1 hour of the time of the telephone call. Children must be 24 hours vomit, diaherra and fever free. Children should not be sent to school with fever reducing medicine.**
