

## What Sets us Apart

- Two Administrators are available to the children, parents and staff on a daily basis.
- We have a head teacher in each individual classroom who has experience working with young children and is required every year by the state to take continuing education workshops. Many of our teachers have a CDA, Associates or Bachelor's Degree.
- Our classrooms exceed the licensing requirement of 35 square feet per child.
- Separate classrooms for each age group allow children an appropriate balance to strengthen skills and succeed with learning.
- We have a three year old classroom designed to meet the needs of those who are still working on mastering their toileting skills.
- We have a large activity room which provides extra space for opportunities such as special in house programs, physical activities and rainy day activity play space.
- Our outdoor space exceeds state requirements and that of any other program in the area. In addition we have a separate play space for Infant through Toddler children.
- Our Creative Curriculum follows the CT Early Learning & Development Standards and is constructed to be developmentally appropriate for each child.
- Story telling is provided with books and flannel boards to promote literacy and an appreciation for reading. Children are given the opportunity to take part in a library experience by borrowing books from our lending library for use at home.
- Staff and administrators are trained in CPR & First Aid. Training also includes Epi—pen and oral medications.
